RATE CHANGES AND CURRENCY FLUCTUATIONS

The 1924 Rate Changes - The 1924 Provisionals

The Condominium Post Office responded to the UPU requirements of specific colours for specific mail types by overprinting the stamps of the relevant colours with the value which corresponded with that service when rates were adjusted in 1924.



A pair of the 10 cent overprinted stamps (obstensably for printed matter) paying the twenty cent inter-colonial rate to New Caledonia. Hals & Collas note that commercial mail bearing the 1924 overprints are Cancelled HC type 8.

17 December 1924

All three overprints used on a cover to the United Kingdom. Rates were struck in French Currency and were thiry cents registration and fify cents overseas postage a total of 80 cents. The rate of exchange in the day was 9cents to one penny hence the payment of 9d (9x9 = 81cents).




