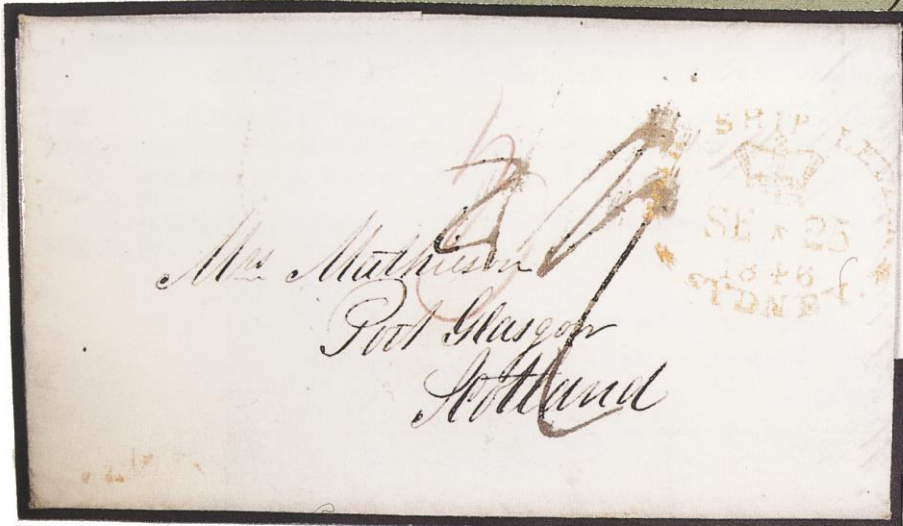

Excepting the famous Nisbet correspondence, early mail is rare. [From bankrupt Kenneth Mathieson who left New Zealand to escape his creditors: "I am bound for China or India but do not know where I shall settle..."] {Page 98.3} | 750T |
